

## **Summer Course Announcement**

### **For first year students (Credit Hours System) – Georgia State University Program**

Summer courses will be offered for the newly admitted first-year students (credit hours system only) for the academic year 2017/2018 according to the following rules:

1. Registration will be available for any freshman student enrolled in the first year (credit hours system only) for the academic year 2017/2018.
2. Each student is allowed to register for a maximum of 2 courses only.
3. Student may register for any compulsory or elective course in which he/she has successfully completed previously, in order to improve his/her GPA. The last grade for that course will be used in calculating the GPA, even if the grade is lower than a previous attempt(s).
4. Registration for the summer course will be at Cairo campus; starting one week after the announcement of the final results, and will last for one week only.
5. Lectures are organized for 4 consecutive weeks with a total of (12) lectures followed by the exams' week.
6. Final exams' schedule for the summer course will be announced along with the lectures' schedule before the beginning of registration.
7. Mid-term exams for the summer course will be held during the first lecture of the third week (the seventh lecture).
8. Final exams for the summer course will last for five days, two periods a day from 9-11 am and 12-2 pm.
9. Same rules regarding attendance, duration of the exams, distribution of grades and assessment of students that were applied during the first and second semesters (fall and spring) are applicable to the summer course.
10. Number of courses to be delivered and classes to be opened during the summer course will depend on staff capacity, minimum number of students per class and will be determined by the faculty board.
11. Registration fees: LE 3500 per course.
